Dear Sh. Shinde,

This is in continuation of the letter sent by the Drug Controller General of India on 16th April, 2020 regarding availability of critical drugs for management of the situation due to COVID-19.

At the outset, I would like to acknowledge the contribution of the Indian Pharma trade channels during these difficult and challenging times. Most of you have strived to continue and maintain availability and supply of important drugs.

By and large, the availability of essential medicines across the country has been satisfactory so far due to your untiring efforts.

In accordance with the clinical management guidelines for COVID-19, Hydroxychloroquine has been recommended as a prophylaxis for certain categories like Health Care Workers and household contacts of positive cases. A combination of Hydroxychloroquine and Azitromycin has also been prescribed for severe patients requiring ICU management. Some other drugs are also presently under various stages of trials but have so far not been recommended for use in India.

A detailed exercise has been undertaken by the Director General of Health Services who has prepared a list of 55 drugs for ICU management and a list of another 96 drugs for general availability and treatment of various co-morbid conditions, which may be required during these times.

Both these lists are being enclosed with this letter. In light of this current pandemic, it is absolutely essential that sufficient market availability of these drugs along with other essential drugs is ensured by your members. These steps will go a long way in the effective clinical management of the pandemic.

I would like to request you to kindly convey this message effectively to your members so that adequate availability of the essential medicines can be ensured during these challenging times of COVID-19.


