Sub: Extension of date of Distribution of food-grain already lifted under Atma Nirbhar Bharat Package (ANBP) -reg.


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Department letter dated 15/16/22.05.2020(copies enclosed) regarding allocation of food-grain for stranded migrants, who are neither covered under National Food Security Act(NFSA) nor State Scheme PDS Cards, providing foodgrains @5 kg per person per month free of cost for a period of two months (May & June, 2020).

2. The validity period of lifting the additional allocation for the month of May, 2020 was upto 31.05.2020 and for June, 2020 was upto 15.06.2020. Later on, vide this Department's letter dated 15.06.2020 (copy enclosed), the validity period of lifting the allocated food-grain for the month of May, 2020 was increased upto 25.06.2020.

3. Requests have been received for increasing the validity period of distribution of already lifted food-grains under ANBP. Accordingly, it has been decided to extend the time for distribution of the quantity of food-grains which has already been lifted (upto 25.06.2020) under ANBP upto 31.08.2020.

Subject: Allocation of foodgrain to the Migrant @ 5kg per person per month for two months free of cost as part of Economic measures (Atma Nirbhar Bharat) reg.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this Department O.M. No. 7-1/2019-BP.III(Pt.)(i) dated 15.05.2020 on the above cited subject, I am to convey allocation of foodgrain for stranded migrants, who are not covered under National Food Security Act (NFSA) or State Scheme PDS Cards @ 5 kg per person per month free of cost for a period of two months (May & June, 2020) as per Annexure.

2. The allocation shown against each State/UT is the maximum limit of allocation under the scheme. The State may utilize it for distribution among stranded migrants as per actual basis or up the limit indicated in the Annexure, whichever is lesser. The states/UTs

(i) Shall use these allocated foodgrains solely for distribution among stranded migrants subject to the condition that they are not covered under the NFSA or any State Scheme PDS Cards.

(ii) Identification of beneficiaries and distribution of foodgrain to such beneficiary will be the responsibility of respective State / UT Government.


(iii) A mechanism may be put in place by the States / UTs to share their details after fully distributing respective allocated foodgrains, with the Department of Food and Public Distribution, by and large on the pattern adopted in the case of PMGKAY.

(iv) States / UTs may report the distribution details with left over/balance foodgrain, if any, to this Department not later than **15 July, 2020**.

3. The validity period for lifting the additional allocation for the month of May, 2020 will be upto 31.05.2020 and for June, 2020 will be upto 15.06.2020. If the States / UTs desires, they may lift the entire additional allocation for the month of May and June, 2020 in one go for which validity period will be 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.


Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Department communication of even number dated 15.5.2020 on the above cited subject vide which it has been decided to allocate free foodgrain for the migrants/stranded migrants, who are not covered under National Food Security Act (NFSA) or State Scheme PDS Cards, @ 5 kg per person per month free of cost for two months (May & June, 2020) to benefit approximately 8 crore migrants/stranded migrants to help mitigate their plight during this precarious COVID-19 situation and to ensure availability of foodgrain to them. It was also conveyed that Government of India will bear the entire cost on account of such distribution.

2. It has been the policy of Government of India that no one should suffer on account of unavailability of foodgrain. Migrant/ stranded migrant workers have been deprived of their livelihood due to Covid-19 related crisis and are as such seen as being unable to access food. The essence of Government of India decision is to make available the foodgrain to such migrant / stranded migrant workers. It is clarified that both migrants and stranded migrants are covered under the scheme subject to the condition that such migrants/stranded migrants are neither covered under NFSA nor have they been issued State Scheme PDS Cards by the State/UT in which they are at present and are not able to access to TPDS ration. The State / UT may use their own mechanism to identify the person accordingly.

3. Further, It is informed that this Department could positively consider allocating wheat in place of rice (within the line of allocation already done) for the period May and June, 2020 if so requested by the states by May 18,2020. It is requested that States / UTs may send their request / requirement, if any, positively by 18.5.2020. A copy of the request may also be emailed to usbp.fpd@nic.in and abhay.kumar35@gov.in

Sir/Madam,

During the Video-conference of the Minister, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, with State Food Ministers on the distribution of foodgrains some states sought clarification regarding distribution of food-grains under Atma Nirbhar Bharat Package.

In this connection, reference is invited to the communication of even number dated 15.5.2020 regarding allocation of foodgrain to the Migrants / Stranded Migrants @ 5 kg per person per month free of cost for two months (May & June, 2020) to benefit approximately 8 crore migrants/stranded migrants.

In continuation of the clarification issued by this Department letter of even number dated 16.5.2020 on the above cited subject, I am directed to further clarify that while identifying the beneficiaries States /UTs may also consider such persons for benefit under the package(within the ceiling conveyed) who do not have any ration card (NFSA / State Ration Card) including migrants / stranded migrants. All such persons may be considered to be entitled for benefit under the Scheme for distribution of food grain @ 5 kg per person per month free of cost for two months (May & June, 2020).

The identification of the beneficiaries is the responsibility of the States / UTs and after implementation of the scheme by June 15, 2020, State Govt may submit utilisation by July 15,2020.

This issues with the approval of Secretary, FPD.

Sir/Madam,


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2. The validity period for lifting the additional allocation for the month of May, 2020 was upto 31.05.2020 and for June, 2020 was upto 15.06.2020. However, request for the extension of validity period for lifting is being received from several States/UTs.

3. Considering the tardy progress of distribution generally and the prevailing situation all over India due to COVID-19, the purpose for which, this additional allocation has been given under Atma Nirbhar Bharat, it has been decided to grant extension of validity period for lifting the unlifted quantity of foodgrains allocated for the month of May and June, 2020 under Atma Nirbhar Bharat (non-NFSA/migrants) upto 25.06.2020.

4. The validity period for above unlifted foodgrains has been extended **as a special case and one-time measure**. The States/UTs Govt. are advised to ensure timely lifting of foodgrains and its timely distribution to the beneficiaries. No request for extension will be considered in future.
