Dr. Ruth Macklin is Professor Emerita at Albert Einstein College of Medicine. She retired from her full-time faculty position on June 30, 2016 after 39 years on the faculty. Her chief research interests are: Research involving human subjects, multinational research, global health, ethics in reproductive health, ethical aspects of research and treatment of HIV/AIDS, human rights.

Prof Macklin is an adviser to the World Health Organization and an elected member of the National Academy of Medicine. She is a past president of the International Association of Bioethics and a former member of the Association's Board of Directors.

She serves on the editorial board of the *Indian Journal of Medical Ethics* has a long standing association with the journal and the FMES network.
