

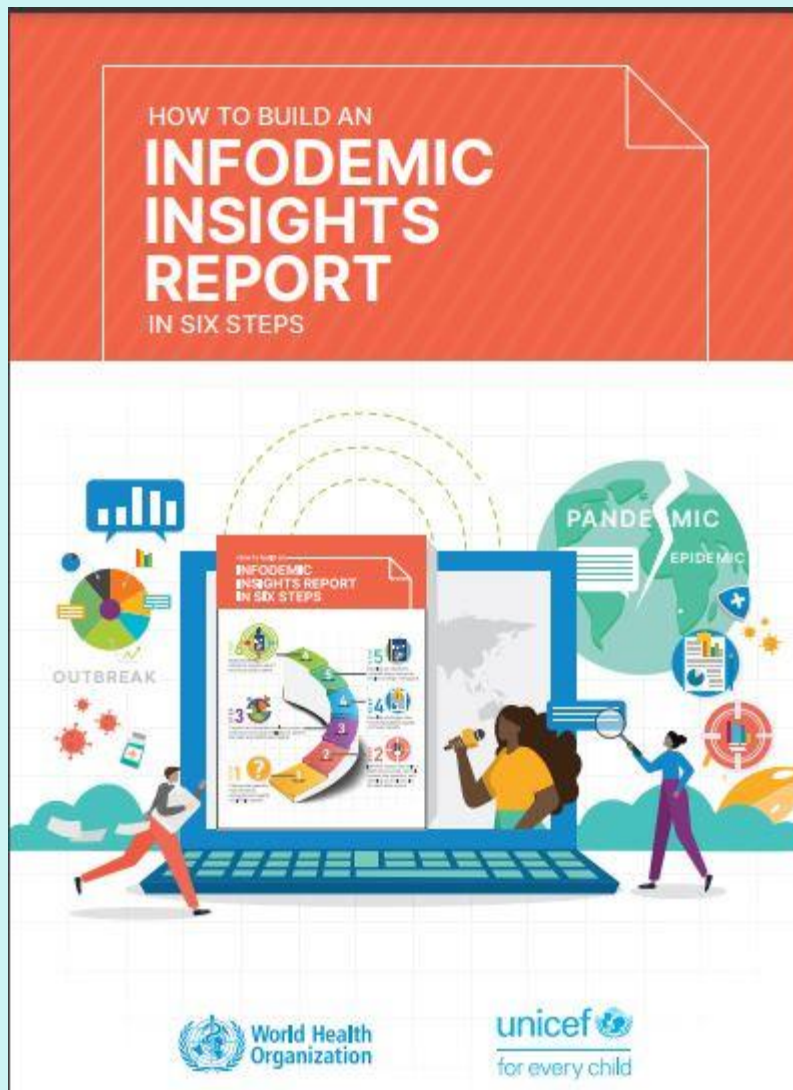

TRAVEL FELLOWSHIP



PURPOSE

Mainstream medical institutions often overlook the contextual realities of India, primarily emphasizing tertiary care. This creates a disconnect between the educational settings and the areas with a dire need for healthcare. To bridge this gap, the fellowship program offers participants the opportunity to visit three initiatives dedicated to primary and secondary care.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Young doctors post MBBS, PG, or mid-career health professionals who are interested in experiential learning through an immersive experience in rural India.

SELECTION

Selection will be based on a written application along with testimonials, followed by an interview. We take up to 3 candidates each year.

STIPEND

A modest stipend will be paid every month, enough to cover your travel and living expenses.

STRUCTURE

The 12 months will be divided into 3 to 4 postings with bridge periods in between. There will be an introductory session, a mid-fellowship meet with co-travellers and a meeting at the end of one year. Mentoring is a vital part of this journey.
